



Summary of TSA Council/Committee Day held on 17th October 2018

- TSA met with a Delegation from The He'nan Administration of Surveying, Mapping & Geo information on 16th August.
- Membership stands at 181 companies, with ten Applications currently being processed
- Council agreed to increase Membership Subscriptions for 2019 by 5%, having previously frozen rates for seven out of the last nine years.
- TSA's Conference will be held on 7th November 2018 at Holdenby House. The theme for the day is 'Surveying Iconic Structures.' The Invitation to Register was sent out on Monday 8th October.
- TSA is producing a series of case studies, with the aim of educating clients and promoting the use of TSA Members for any survey project.
- It was agreed to make the Theft Mitigation Measures Briefing Note and accompanying A4 Poster available to everyone and is available to download from the website.
- The updated Client Guide on Photogrammetry, endorsed by RICS and CharteredICES was uploaded early October.
- Ruth Adams started as Survey School Manager at the beginning of October.
- TSA is a media partner of the Commercial UAV Show (14th – 15th November 2018), Plantworx 2019 (11th-13th June), GeoDATA (29th November 2018) and Flood & Coast 2019 (18th – 20th June 2019).
- Both TSA and the Survey School will be exhibiting at GEOBusiness 2019 (21st-22nd May 2019)
- Over 245 people have registered for the Level 3 Diploma and over 70 applicants are being assessed.
