

Summary of TSA Council meeting held on 25 April 2012

- Graham Mills welcomed Mark Combes of Severn Partnership and Adam Bradley of Jacobs to their first Council meeting. Olivia Masters of Infoterra has been co-opted onto Council after the resignation of Stuart McKendrick of 40SEVEN.
- A record number (27) of Application Packs had been requested between the January and April meetings.
- Excellent feedback has been received from attendees regarding the Health & Safety Seminar (22nd Feb) and the BIM Technical Seminar (28th March). A BIM Working Group will be set up with Autodesk. Leica are putting on a Monitoring Seminar for Members on 27th June – more details will be sent shortly.
- TSA's AGM was held at the new Ordnance Survey HQ in Southampton on Thursday 19th April. The AGM was followed by a very stimulating discussion on education. The updated Network RTK report was launched in the afternoon and is already being downloaded from TSA's Website.
- The next Discussion Group will be held on 7th November at the National Space Centre in Leicester. The day will be themed 'Above and Below'.
- TSA's website will be relaunched within the next few weeks, with a new design.
- TSA's group on LinkedIn currently has well over 900 members and is open to non-members. The PR Committee will create some Group Rules, to ensure that non-Members are not using the group to promote themselves or their services. TSA also has over 300 followers on Twitter.
