

Summary of TSA Council meeting held on 24th April 2013

- Council welcomed Oliver Viney from Atlantic Geomatics as he had been co-opted at the AGM last week.
- TSA's AGM was held on 17th April 2013, at the National Railway Museum in York. The afternoon session was devoted to BIM. The feedback has been excellent.
