



## **Summary of TSA Council meeting held on 20<sup>th</sup> July 2016**

- TSA is pursuing both an RFQ and also an Apprenticeship Scheme. Members will be kept fully informed.
- The GEO Business Show was a success and TSA's joint stand was extremely busy. The event stats show that total attendance was up by 10% on 2015. Around 70% of exhibitors have rebooked for 2017 (Show dates 23<sup>rd</sup> & 24<sup>th</sup> May 2017).
