



Summary of TSA Council meeting held on 18th October 2017

- The Council meeting followed a new, restructured format where reporting from the morning Committee sessions was kept to a minimum with more time available to discuss wider issues
- 14 Membership Applications are currently being processed
- Membership stands at 178 companies
- A detailed PR plan has been drawn up for the last quarter of 2017 and into 2018
- Council agreed to freeze Membership Subscription rates for 2018 (previously frozen 2009 – 2011 and again from 2014-2016)
- The TSA Conference will be held on 8th November at the Great Western Railway Museum in Swindon. A TSA branded delegate pack will be issued to attendees.
- TSA continue to work on a new initiative to assist members who have suffered survey equipment theft
- Level 3 Diploma Assessors are currently being trained and over 110 people have registered for the qualification
- Work will begin on a new Business Plan for TSA and members involvement will be sought
- The Geospatial Apprenticeship Standards and Assessment plans have all been approved by government. No delivery partners have been found as yet.
- TSA's group on LinkedIn currently has over 3,600 members and is open to non-members. TSA also has over 2,500 followers on Twitter (@surveyassoc).
